Subject: Executive Order 14042 on Ensuring Adequate COVID-19 Safety Protocols for
Federal Contractors and Subcontractors

Dear Meggitt Supplier,

On September 9, 2021, the President of the United States issued [Executive Order 14042, Ensuring Adequate COVID Safety Protocols for Federal Contractors \(EO\)](#), which resulted in the Safer Workplace Task Force publishing new Implementation Guidance (link to current guidance is provided [here](#)). This EO requires that a COVID-19 clause be included in certain new, extended and renewed federal contracts and subcontracts and solicitations, including prime solicitations, contracts, task orders, delivery orders and modifications thereof.

The Department of Defense (DoD) and National Aeronautics and Space Administration (NASA) have each issued a class deviation clause to implement the requirements of Executive Order 14042; see [DFARS 252.223-7999 Ensuring Adequate COVID-19 Safety Protocols for Federal contractors \(Deviation 2021-O0009\) for DoD](#) and [FAR 52.223-99 Ensuring Adequate COVID-19 Safety Protocols for Federal Contractors \(Oct 2021\) \(Deviation\) for NASA](#). All suppliers who support Federal Government contracts must familiarize themselves with these new clauses.

When included in a federal contract or subcontract, the COVID-19 clause(s) requires parties that contract with the Federal Government to provide COVID-19 safeguards, including meeting vaccination requirements in workplaces with individuals working on or in connection with a Federal Government contract. This requirement will be incorporated into covered prime solicitations, contracts, task orders, delivery orders and modifications thereof, as appropriate, which will result in required updates to impacted Supplier purchase contracts. Some government agencies such as OSHA and Home Land Security may issue additional guidance in the near future.
